**DAY 4: ST. BARBE–BLANC SABLON–RED BAY–L'ANSE-AU-CLAIR.** Scenic ferry crossing on the Strait of Belle Isle (Iceberg Alley) to Blanc Sablon and drive to Red Bay. RED BAY Visit Red Bay National Historic site (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). Drive to L'Anse-au-Clair. (B,D)
