Menu Options Include:

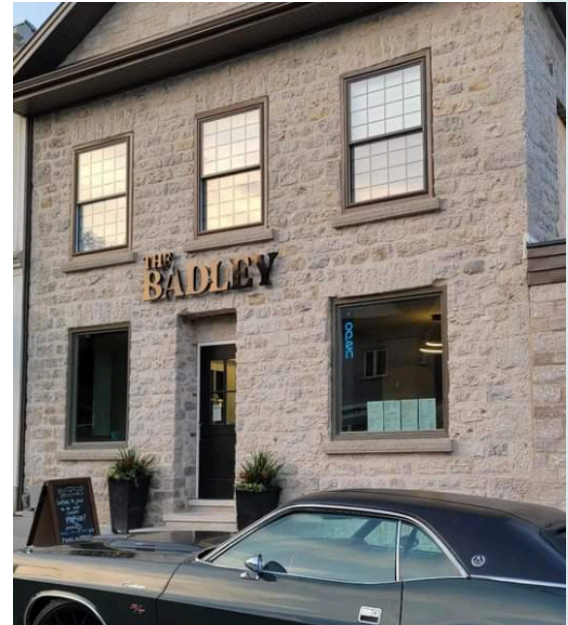
- Fish and Chips - *Beer battered cod, tartar sauce, creamy coleslaw and lemon*
