Day 1: Friday, September 25, 2026 Ottawa, Ontario

Day 4: Monday, September 28, 2026 Halifax, Nova Scotia

Begin your day at one of Canada’s most extraordinary natural wonders — Hopewell Rocks on the Bay of Fundy, where the highest tides in the world have carved incredible rock formations. Continue to the lively city of Halifax, Nova Scotia’s vibrant capital, for a guided tour highlighting its history, culture, and charming waterfront.

Day 5: Tuesday, September 29, 2026 Nova Scotia South Shore

Discover the beauty of Nova Scotia’s South Shore, beginning with breakfast at Peggy’s Cove, home to Canada’s most photographed lighthouse. Explore the colourful fishing village of Lunenburg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before visiting picturesque Mahone Bay. Return to Halifax for an evening that includes a visit to Fairview Lawn Cemetery, the final resting place for many Titanic passengers.





**Day 6: Wednesday, September 30, 2026
Baddeck, Nova Scotia**

Travel north to Cape Breton Island, often hailed as one of the world’s most beautiful islands. Visit the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site, where you’ll learn about the fascinating inventions of this world-famous innovator. In the evening, enjoy a lively ceilidh, a traditional Maritime kitchen party filled with music, laughter, and fun.

Day 7: Thursday, October 1, 2026 Cabot Trail Touring, Nova Scotia

Prepare for one of the most scenic days of your life as you travel the legendary Cabot Trail through Cape Breton Highlands National Park. This breathtaking drive offers panoramic ocean views, mountain lookouts, and endless photo opportunities — a day of pure natural beauty and East Coast wonder.

**Day 8: Friday, October 2, 2026
Charlottetown, PEI**

Montreal, Quebec**
