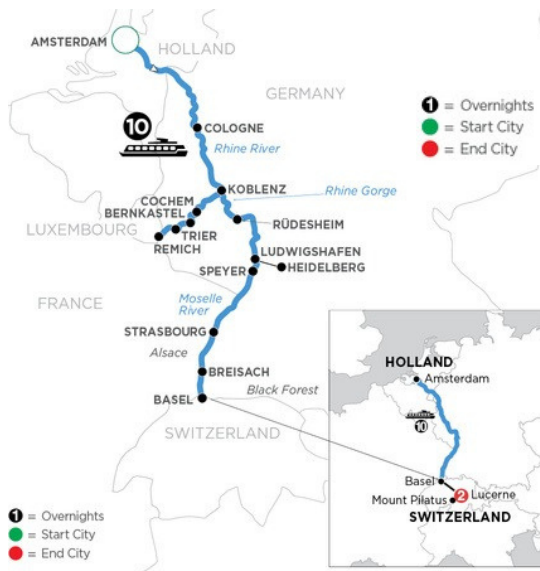

DAY 1. Depart from Toronto - Amsterdam

DAY 2. AMSTERDAM, HOLLAND (EMBARKATION).

Welcome to Holland. Your Suite Ship® is Ready for Boarding. Flights into Amsterdam must arrive by 3:30 pm. Guests must be on board ship by 5 pm. Your day in Amsterdam is free to explore at your leisure.

OVERNIGHT DOCKING IN AMSTERDAM

DAY 3. AMSTERDAM. Colorful Canals of Amsterdam. Visit the Adventure Center for today's activities with your Adventure Host. Discovery Excursion, discover the true beauty of Amsterdam with an off-the-beaten-path Guided Walking Tour through its cobblestone streets for a captivating look at this legendary city, OR: Classic Excursion, explore the iconic waterways of Amsterdam on a Guided Canal Cruise past stately homes of Amsterdam's "Golden Age."

DAY 4. COLOGNE, GERMANY. Prost! Celebrate in the Rhineland.
